

INNER BORDER ASSEMBLY

In the previous set of cutting instructions you were instructed to cut strips for the inner borders:

Fabric B - Romanesque	(2) 1" by 28 1/2" strips; inner border #1
	(2) 1" by 29 1/2" strips; inner border #1
Fabric E - Brushed Tile	(2) 3/4" by 29 1/2" strips; inner border #2
	(2) 3/4" by 30" strips; inner border #2
Fabric I - Fresco Floral	(2) 1 3/4" by 30" strips; inner border #3
	(2) 1 3/4" by 32 1/2" strips; inner border #3

Your Center square should measure 28 1/2" before adding these borders.

Your final square should measure 32 1/2" after adding these borders. Square to 32 1/2" so that next round will fit.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

14. INNER BORDER #1: Sew (1) B 1" x (28 1/2") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) B 1" x (29 1/2") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

15. INNER BORDER #2: Sew (1) E 3/4" x (29 1/2") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) E 3/4" x (30") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

16. INNER BORDER #3: Sew (1) I 1 3/4" x (30") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) I 1 3/4" x (32 1/2") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.
