
SPOOLS



Make 4 6 1/2" blocks

For each block you will need

Fabric A - Background

- 4 11/2" squares
- 2 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- 2 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Fabric E - spool ends

2 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

Fabric F - spool center


1 2 1/2"x 4 1/2" rectangle

Draw a diagonal line on four fabric A 1 1/2" squares.

Place one square on each end of the fabric E 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Stitch on the drawn line. Cut away the excess, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press triangle outward. Trim to 1 1/2" x 4 1/2".



Stitch one fabric A 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to each side of one fabric F 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle. Add the spool base to the top and bottom.



Stitch one fabric A 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle to each side of the spool block. Square to 6 1/2".

Repeat these steps to make the required number of each block.
