

INTRO

Instructions are for 33" x 33" (51" x 69" instructions will be in parentheses)

You will need:

1 (3 1/2) yd of medium to dark scraps

1 (3 1/2) yd of neutral scraps

1/3 (2/3) yd border fabric

Tri-recs ruler set (optional)

Square in Square ruler (optional)

CLUE #1

Make 16 (68) scrappy neutral and print 4 patches measuring 3 1/2" unfinished.

Use 2" squares to make a 3" finished/ 3 1/2" unfinished 4-patch. You will use 2 color squares and 2 neutral squares.

To make multiple patches quickly you can strip piece a 2" strip of color and a 2" strip of neutral and then sub cut into 2" pieces to get 2 patches. Then mix them up and put (2) 2- patches together to make a 4-patch.



Tips

Press 2-patches or strips to the dark side.

Check out the back side of your fabrics...they might make good neutrals
