

Square Deal Option



Color 1 - one yard
Color 2 - one yard
Color 3 - one yard
Background - one yard

These instructions were converted from the original pattern. You can probably conserve fabric by cutting more squares from each strip, especially on color 1 unless you are fussy cutting.

Background fabric:

Cut (2) strips 5 1/4" wide by the WOF (width of fabric). From those strips, cut (18) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles
Cut (1) strip 5 1/2" wide. From that strip, cut (1) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares, (2) 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles and (4) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares.
Label these with their size.
Cut (4) strips 4 1/2" wide by the WOF for the border.

Color 1 – (23) 4 3/4" squares

Cut (2) strips 4 3/4" wide by the WOF. Cut that strip into (10) 4 3/4" x 4 3/4" squares. If you are fussy cutting, cut these on point.
Cut (2) strips 4 3/4" wide by the WOF. Cut those strips into (9) 4 3/4" x 4 3/4" squares. If you are fussy cutting, cut these on point.
Cut (1) strip 4 3/4" wide by the WOF. Cut that strip into (4) 4 3/4" x 4 3/4" squares. If you are fussy cutting, cut these on point

Color 1 light

Cut (1) strip 5 1/4" wide by the WOF. Cut that strip into (14) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles. Cut (1) strip 5 1/2" wide by the WOF. Cut that strip into (1) 3" x 5 1/2" rectangle and (5) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles
Cut (2) strips 5 1/4" wide by the WOF. Cut those strips into (18) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles
Cut (1) strip 5 1/4" wide by the WOF. Cut that strip into (8) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles.

Color 1 dark

Cut (1) strip 5 1/4" wide by the WOF. Cut that strip into (14) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles. Cut (1) strip 5 1/2" wide by the WOF. Cut that strip into (1) 3" x 5 1/2" rectangle and (5) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles.
Cut (2) strips 5 1/4" wide by the WOF. Cut those strips into (18) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles.
Cut (1) strip 5 1/4" wide by the WOF. Cut that strip into (3) 3" x 5 1/4" rectangles.
